



Holiday Cheer Game

BEGINNER PLAY

Each player chooses a game piece and places it on the white arrow to start.

The first player rolls the foam die. The icon that lands on top (snowflake, snowman, little boy, or Let It Snow) indicates that the player can then move his or her game piece forward to the first square that matches the die.

Play continues with each player rolling the die and then moving forward to the next square with the icon shown on the die. If a blank side lands face up, then the player cannot move forward and must wait until the next turn for a chance to move forward.

The winner is the first player to roll and reach the final snowflake at the end of the game.

ADVANCED PLAY

In advanced play, two or more game pieces cannot share a game square. If a square is occupied when the next player comes along to land on the same square, then the original player get knocked backward to the nearest matching icon directly behind the current square. For example, if the game has just begun and player one rolls a snowman icon, he or she moves forward to the first snowman icon. Then, if player two also rolls the same snowman icon, he or she would place his or her game piece on the snowman icon and remove the first player's game piece back to start.

Feel free to make up your own rules and variations for advanced play.
